ALUMNI ASSOCIATION COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Westminster Academy Alumni Board will be awarding two scholarships to seniors, each valued at \$1000.*

Scholarship Criteria:

- Submit a 500-word essay, based on the prompts
- Personal testimony
- GPA minimum 3.0
- Details of extra curricular activities
- Two Teacher/Coach recommendations
- Open to college-bound seniors only (funds must be used towards college costs)
- Proven leadership or community involvement (student government, teen advisors, chapel, sports, drama, mission trip, etc.)
- Any additional information that shows the student participates in school functions
- Community service hours in excess of school requirement
- Exhibits Christ-like and Godly character (represents alumni well!)
- College plans

Must be submitted by the end of March.

The winners will be awarded their scholarship and certificates at the Senior Recognition Night in May.

The scholarship winners will be presented at the Alumni-sponsored senior chapel/lunch.

Application checklist

Use the following checklist in order to assure that the application process is complete.

Your application will not be considered unless the following are included:

- Two teacher/coach recommendations
- All pages of the application (completed in full, signed and dated)
- Essay (no more than 500 words)

*Funding for this award is a direct result of generous contributions to the Westminster Academy Alumni Association Scholarship Fund. The Alumni Board will judge finalists based upon application criteria and essay review. All decisions made by the Alumni Board are final.
