### **Quarantine Learning Statement**

During the 2020-21 school year Westminster Academy offered in-person classes and a blend of synchronous and asynchronous virtual classroom learning. Students had the option to utilize either. Whether the in-person or virtual format was utilized by the student, the block schedule was maintained and high school students attended four classes every other day on a rotating basis. Attendance was kept for live virtual classes and virtual students took quizzes, tests and exams in-person, on campus after school hours

Comprehensive exams were given in academic subjects at the end of each semester in high school. These exams represent no more than 20% and no less than 15% of the semester grade with the exception of dual enrollment courses in which the exam may be worth up to 25% of the semester grade.
